Introducing The Norfolk Austin Seven Club

The **Norfolk Austin Seven Club** was formed in January 2005, to foster interest in, the preservation of and use of Pre-War Austin Sevens, its variants, other Austin cars and old cars in general. As at October 2011 we have 77 joint memberships (joint members have equal voting rights in the club), with 105 Pre-War Austin 7s.

The Monthly Meetings are normally held on the evening of the 3rd Tuesday of each month, January through to November, from about 7.30 pm onwards, at the East Tuddenham Jubilee Hall, near Norwich (just off the A47 between Norwich and Dereham). The idea is to have a chat with friends who have a similar interest in Austin Sevens and old cars in general, over a convivial drink. Sometimes we have a visiting speaker. The December meeting is our Club Dinner and takes place on the 2nd Tuesday (instead of the 3rd Tuesday).

During the year we have various roads runs around the county, and visits to interesting sights. We are only too willing to help members with whatever they want to do so that they can enjoy their A7 to the full. If you are looking for an Austin 7 we can help and if you need advice on repairs and maintenance we can help as well. For the more adventurous in May an annual road run to Holland is organised by a group of fellow Austin 7 enthusiasts.

The cost of membership to the Norfolk Austin Seven Club is only £12 per year. Each Membership is a "Joint Membership" for two people, who both have full club rights. The newsletter of the Norfolk Austin Seven Club, the *Norfolk NA 7ter*, is sent out quarterly. It is also thoroughly recommended that you subscribe to the quarterly magazine from the Austin 7 Clubs Association, known as "The Grey Mag", which is the source of a lot of useful information and only costs £8 per annum. Those members who are on broadband can receive copies of other Austin 7 Clubs' magazines via email if they wish.

The Norfolk Austin Seven Club is a Member of the Austin 7 Clubs Association, which means that members of the NA7C are able to benefit from reduced price rates of insurance cover for their Austin Seven from the Richard Hoskins Insurance Company, under their Classic Car Insurance Scheme. (The insurance for my 1933 Austin 7 costs £50 for unlimited mileage and UK/Europe breakdown recovery)

The Norfolk Austin Seven Club is also a member of the Association of Norfolk Car Clubs, which is a group of some thirty car clubs, who organise events such as a barbeque in July and circulate details of all the various car rallies in the Norfolk/Suffolk region throughout the year.

We have a Club Car Valuer who can value members' cars, on a club night, by prior arrangement through the Club Chairman, for a nominal charge of £10 (which will go towards club funds).
